

Frazier's Fool Jig

A 48 bar jig for couple facing couple, longways progressive.
Composed 1 April 1981 by Terry O'Neal for Frazier Worth.

(16) **Whirlygig.**

- (4) Holding inside hands, 1s pass between the 2s and turn them with their free hands. All dance home.
- (4) 1st man and 2nd lady take near hands and dance between 2nd man and 1st lady. Turn them with free hands and all dance home.
- (8) Repeat, 2nd man leading.

(8) **Telescope & 1/2 Turn** with your partner by the Right hand.

(8) **Irish Chain** into a

(8) **Double Irish Hey.**

- (2) Ladies come out of the chain facing out of the set and cast Left, while the men trade places passing Left shoulders.
- (2) Ladies trade places passing Right shoulders while the men cast Right.
- (2) Ladies cast Left while the men cross to place passing Left shoulders.
- (2) Ladies trade places passing Right shoulders and loop Right while the men loop Left.

Men dance on the men's diagonal and the ladies dance on the ladies' diagonal.

(8) **Around the House (Swing & Change)** 1/2 or 1-1/2 to face a new couple. Both couples need to do the same.
